
- Nashik is an ancient holy city in Maharashtra. On the banks of Godavari river is Panchavati, a temple complex.

- Trimbakeshwar Shiva temple which is one of the twelve jyotirlinga, located in Nashik district also adds to its religious beauty.




- The city is called 'Wine capital of India' as half of India's vineyards are located here.
