Sir/Madam,

- To assess the available facilities of teaching, non-teaching, hospital staff, practical training and other infrastructure facilities at your college **Ayurved Seva Sangh's Ayurved, Mahavidyalaya Ganeshwadi Near Gadage Maharaj Bridge, Panchavati Tal. Dist. Nashik-422003, Maharashtra (AYU0143)** inspection was conducted on **24.03.2025 and 25.03.2025 on Hybrid mode** as a part of annual visitation by the visitation team of Medical Assessment and Rating Board, NCISM to process the permission **with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 03 PG Course in the subject namely (1) kayachikitsa (05 seats) (ii) Shalya (04 seats) (iii) Panchakarma(01 seat) for the academic session 2025-26 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
- The visitation report and all other related documents were assessed in terms of enforced regulations namely the Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals Regulations, 2024 ", provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations **there under and as per the Visitor Observation following shortcomings/defects have been observed:-.**

1. Teaching staff-

a) Availability of Teaching staff is $\frac{\text{Available}}{\text{Required}} \times 100\% = \frac{29}{30} \times 100\% = 96\%$.

The assessment report was duly placed in the **123rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 23.05.2025** and Board concluded that the college is not fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations but fulfilling the criteria for issuance of extended permission in accordance with the Board's policy letter issued on **09.01.2025 & 20.01.2025**. Hence, the Board decided to issue extended permission with intake capacity of **60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 03 PG Courses in the subjects namely : - (i)Kayachikitsa - 05 seats, (ii) shalya- 04 seats, (iii)panchakarma - 01 seats, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2025-26.**
4. The assessment report was duly placed in the **123rd Board meeting of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) convened on 23.05.2025** and Board concluded that the college is fulfilling the notified & requisite criteria for issuance of extended permission as per the Concerned Acts and regulations. Hence, the Board decided to issue **Extended permission) with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 03 PG Course in the subject namely (1) kayachikitsa (05 seats) (ii) Shalya (04 seats) (iii) Panchakarma (01 seat) for the academic session 2025-26 as per the provision under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020, for the academic session 2025-26.**

"DECISION"

5. **Therefore, Extended permission in accordance with regulation 54(2) of MESAR UG Ayurveda 2024 is hereby granted to Ayurved Seva Sangh's Ayurved, Mahavidyalaya Ganeshwadi Near Gadage Maharaj Bridge,Panchavati Tal.Dist. Nashik-422003, Maharashtra (AYU0143) is hereby granted with Extended permission with intake capacity of 60 seats (75 seats including EWS) in UG (BAMS) course and 10 seats in 03 PG Course in the subject namely (1) kayachikitsa (05 seats) (ii) Shalya (04 seats) (iii) Panchakarma(01 seat)as per the provision in accordance with regulation of 15(5) of the MESAR PG Ayurveda 2024 under section 28 of NCISM , for the academic session 2025-26 subject to the conditions below mentioned condition shall be fulfilled:-**
- I. **Minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity 60 seats (75 seats including EWS and 10 seats in 03 PG Course shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2025-26 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
6. **Admissions** made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
7. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
8. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
9. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college as per Regulation 55 (2) of MESAR 2024 and the compliance report shall be submitted before 31st December, 2025 to be considered for the process of issuance of permission for the academic session 2026-2027:-**
 - i) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled,
 - ii) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024,

- iii) All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
- iv) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum Essential Standards, Assessment and Rating for Postgraduate Institutions and Minimum Standards for Postgraduate Education in Ayurveda) Regulations, 2024
- v) The shortcoming is mentioned in para no.2

10. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college within the timeline as mentioned above to the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2026-27.
